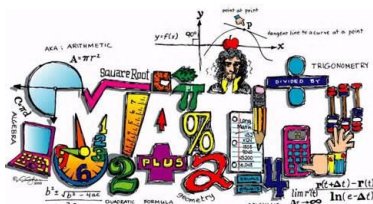

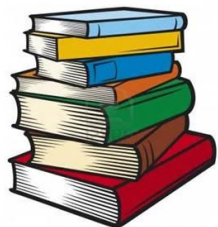

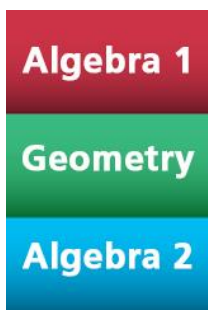

### EDU- UPDATES

- A **24 hour** notice of cancelation and/or request form must be completed prior to the next session schedule.
- Our registration fee is **\$100.00**. This yearly fee pays for supplies & educational subscriptions which all members enjoy. It also allows for us to provide a variety of monthly workshops (free to members)
- Partner in Education schools will receive **\$25 OFF** the registration fee.

## Parenting Tips

- **After your child has stopped to correct a word he has read, have him go back and reread the entire sentence from the beginning to make sure he understands what the sentence is saying.**
- **Request that your child's teacher schedule after-school math tutoring sessions if your child really needs help.**

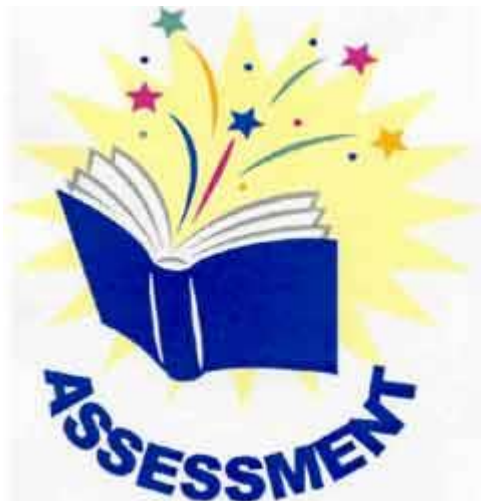
